Welcome to your Travel Plan Pack

Welcome to your dedicated Travel Plan Pack. Here you will find information on how to take up more sustainable travel opportunities in Warsash. As part of Rivercross, a Travel Plan has been produced, which sets out strategies to increase the level of sustainable travel and minimise the impact of development traffic on local roads and the environment. By promoting and monitoring travel taken by residents, the Travel Plan will aim to:

- Support a range of sustainable transport alternatives to provide the residents with options for sustainable travel to and from the site.
- Develop an awareness of the options for sustainable travel to and from the site and local area amongst residents.
- Promote car sharing, walking, cycling and public transport as safe, efficient, affordable alternatives to private cars and highlight the health and environmental benefits of using sustainable travel modes.
- Minimise the impact of car-based travel to the site on the local and strategic highway network and environment.

Here you will find a range of up to date information on walking and cycling routes, public transport, and other local opportunities in and around Warsash.

Your Development

Rivercross is located in Warsash, a maritime village located in the south of Hampshire, at the mouth of the River Hamble. The development will add 140 new homes to the local community. With local facilities available in Warsash, Park Gate and Fareham, there are plenty of different options to explore.





Your Local Area

Rivercross is situated in the heart of Warsash, to the East of Brook Lane. Warsash has a range of retail, leisure, education and employment opportunities which you have access to.

Walking and Cycling

Rivercross is surrounded by a number of walking and cycling routes providing access to destinations nearby and the rest of Hampshire.

Brook Lane connects your development to the harbour and the centre of Warsash. To the North, you can make the most of fantastic, picturesque walks along the river Hamble.

Route 2 of the National Cycle Network runs directly through Warsash and forms a spectacular 361 mile long route between Dover and St. Austell in Cornwall. It takes you past quintessentially British seaside towns and splendid views of the southern coastline.





Public Transport

Bus Travel

The nearest bus stops to the site are located on Brook Lane approximately 180m south of the site. The bus stop provides a shelter, seating and is featured with a flag and timetable information.

This bus stop is served by:

- Solent Ranger X5 between Southampton, Gosport and Portsmouth via interchange with the X4 at • Locks Heath
- Blue Star School Service 602 between Warsash and Barton Peveril College. •
- Blue Star School Service 610 between Locks Heath and Barton Peveril College.

School Travel

St Marys Church Hall Preschool & Warsash Day Nursery and Preschool

St Marys Church Hall Preschool and Warsash Day Nursery and Preschool are located to the South of Rivercross on Church Road and can be accessed via foot or cycle along Brook Lane and then Warsash Road. There is a designated crossing point along Church Road, providing safe access to both school entrances, with St Marys Church Hall Preschool to the East and Warsash Day Nursery and Preschool to the West.

Hook-With-Warsash C of E Primary School

Hook-With-Warsash Church of England Primary School is located to the South of Rivercross on Church Road and can be accessed via foot or cycle along Brook Lane and then Warsash Road. There is a designated crossing point along Church Road, providing safe access to the school entrance.


Locks Heath Junior School

Locks Heath Junior School can be found to the East of Rivercross on Warsash Road. The school is accessible via foot or bicycle from the Brook Lane site access, before heading East along Warsash Road. There is a pelican crossing to the front of the school, as well as a bus stop providing the X5 bus service.

Brookfield Community School

Brookfield Community School is located to the North East of Rivercross on Brook Lane. There is a designated crossing point to the front of the school, providing safe access for pedestrians and cyclists.

What's Next?

Monitoring Reports & Survey

As part of the Travel Plan, Rivercross at Warsash is required to monitor the uptake of sustainable travel over a 5 year period. This monitoring will inform the success against the targets which are to be agreed with Hampshire County Council.

Monitoring will be in the form of questionnaire surveys throughout the monitoring period. These surveys will determine the level of different forms of travel undertaken by residents and will help understand any barriers to particular types of travel. The results from these monitoring surveys will be reviewed and monitoring reports will be produced to understand the effectiveness of the Travel Plan which allow for any changes to be made.
